

CMA Men's Ministry National Coordinator Meeting Summary
August 6-7, 2004

:Five National Coordinators met with the CMA Men's Ministry National Director, Jim Peterson in Colorado Springs, CO, August 6-7, 2004. The coordinators:

- Developed a strategy for advancing fund raising for our support of the 2005 New Official Workers Forum in Quito, Ecuador. Outlined communications with district coordinators and district superintendents. Prepared suggested approaches for district coordinators to use in contacting men's ministry leaders in local churches.
- Developed a strategy for energizing men's ministry in districts without a district coordinator.
- Identified selection criteria to assist district superintendents and district executive committees in appointing district coordinators.
- Began the process of establishing a ministry for discipling young men.
- Defined criteria for measuring progress toward our vision. Prepared survey questions for annual reporting by district coordinators.
- Reviewed a draft men's ministry constitution and appointed a subcommittee to prepare the document for legal review and board of managers action.
- Received a report that funds are available to satisfy known expenses.

The National Leadership Team, consisting of district coordinators, will meet in Atlanta, GA, January 28-29, 2005.
