

**Report of C&MA Men's Ministry National Leadership Team Meeting
January 28-29, 2005**

The C&MA Men's National Leadership Team met January 28-29, 2005 at the Airport Comfort Inn, Atlanta, GA. Fifteen men attended representing eleven districts.

National Project. \$10,700 has been sent in with more to come from several districts. The scope of the project has been reduced. The plan is to send at least one new worker from each district on a short term missions trip in 2005. New workers from participating districts will have priority. A letter has been drafted to explain the changes.

General Council Men's Luncheon, May 28, 2005. David Delk, President of Man-in-the-Mirror, will be the featured speaker. Tickets will be \$20. Tickets should be purchased when registering for Council since only a few tickets will be available at the men's booth.

Financial Report. The 2003-2004 financial records are being audited. The current balance in the account is \$13,539.61. Known expenses are \$16,768 through the end of the year.

Funding Issues. An ad hoc group was appointed to develop ideas on ways to raise funds.

Training and Resources. District coordinators were encouraged to attend National Coalition of Men's Ministry (NCMM) conferences as an excellent source of information on men's ministries. NCMM conferences also provide great networking opportunities with national men's ministry leaders.

Survey. The National leadership Team will be conducting a brief survey to determine the health of men's ministry across the Alliance. Expected completion: April 15.

Men's Ministry Sunday. The team is developing a concept for a national men's Sunday to be implemented in 2006.

Young Men's Coordinator. An ad hoc team was appointed to seek ways to address the needs of 18-25 year olds. Actions required include the preparation of a job description, appointment of a man to fill the position and identifying ministry resources.

Proposed Constitution. A proposed C&MA Men's Ministry constitution is in the final stages of review before going to the Board of Directors for approval.

Next Meeting. The next meeting will be held August 26-27, 2005, with the location is to be determined.
